RESOLUTION

NEW YORK CLASS B AIRSPACE REDESIGN

WHEREAS, The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is proposing to increase the size the of the Class B Airspace in the New York Metropolitan area, and

WHEREAS, the FAA has notified the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) of this potential modification to the airspace, and

WHEREAS, the FAA has formed an ad hoc committee consisting of airports and industry representatives that may be impacted by this modification, and

WHEREAS, NYSDOT, through Republic Airport management, is a member of this ad hoc committee, and

WHEREAS, Republic Airport has informed the FAA that the airspace modification has the potential for negative economic, environmental, and safety impacts to the airport, and

WHEREAS, the Republic Airport Commission has reviewed the modification to increase the Class B Airspace and concurs with NYSDOT's concerns regarding potential impacts to Republic Airport.

NOW AND THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Republic Airport Commission recommends the New York State Department of Transportation continue its opposition to the Federal Aviation Administration modification to increase the size of the Class B Airspace and seek a compromise which reduces or eliminates the impacts.
